All the wines contained herein are good, many are great. Our intention is to offer you “around the globe” variety, not only focusing on a few prominent viticultural regions.

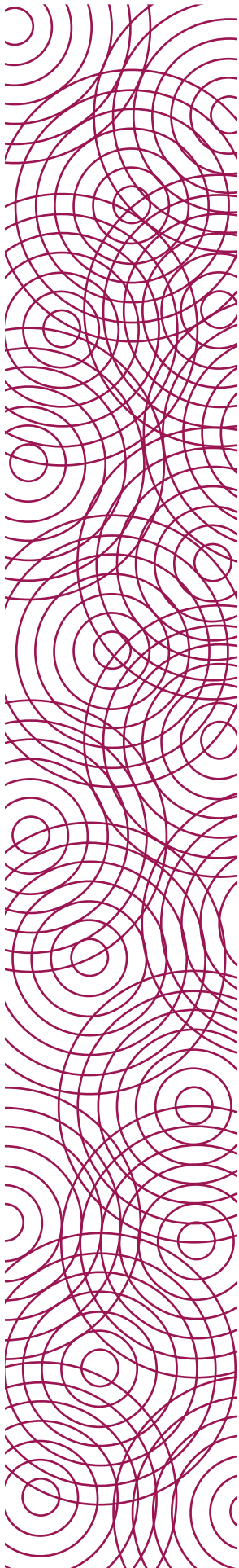

A NOTE ON CABERNET FRANC:

This is the third most planted varietal in Bordeaux, contributing more delicate tannin and aromatic complexity to the typical Bordeaux blend. The American examples are bigger wines, with more structure and concentration. Notes of juicy fruit flavor, raspberries and tobacco.
